



ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Casas Pepe Apartments, located in the tourist city of Playa del Inglés, on the island of Gran Canaria, is committed to developing its activity as a tourist accommodation, respecting the environment and minimizing the impact that its commercial activity can cause in the surrounding ecosystems.

With this commitment we want to contribute to the sustainable development of our municipality and our island, so that it can be known in the tourist markets as a destination that respects the environment.

To carry out our commitment to environmental policy, we intend to achieve the following objectives:

- 1- Identify which parts of the hotel's daily activity can have a negative impact on the environment and modify or control it so that this impact is reduced to the minimum possible.
- 2- To have the protection of the environment as one of the parameters to be studied when launching a new activity or service within the hotel.
- 3- Sensitize all the hotel staff so that each one of them, from their workplace, can contribute to the preservation of the environment, carrying out their tasks following the established guidelines, in order to avoid generating harmful waste, unduly treated or negative impacts on the environment.
- 4- Comply with the legal environmental norms that refer to the activities that are developed; go beyond that whenever possible and provide some additional benefit to the environmental management of the hotel.
- 5- To inform and train all parties related to the hotel's activity, be they employees, clients, suppliers, etc., on environmental issues with the objective of making them feel involved in the preservation of the environment.
- 6- Inform hotel guests of the natural parks or protected areas that exist in the surrounding area so that they can get to know them and collaborate in their preservation.
- 7- To collaborate in projects of the public administrations in the matter of sustainability, as well as those created by the associations of which we form part, since we believe that it can be a good beginning to position the industry of the tourism in the island to the vanguard in the preservation and regeneration of the environment.

With this declaration of principles and the consequent achievement of its objectives, we hope to obtain a continuous improvement in the treatment of the environmental impacts generated by the hotel activity, thus contributing to the fact that in the near future the island of Gran Canaria has the international reputation of being a tourist destination where both its inhabitants and the companies are respectful of the environment.

We are aware that the environment is our most valuable heritage, and that we are responsible for taking care of it for our own benefit and that of all those who wish to visit us to enjoy it, and we must also preserve it for future generations, who have the right to find an environment in good conditions and with sufficient natural resources.
